Rio, before you land: the three decisions that do the safety work

Rio's travel advisory is the same Level 2 as France and Italy, and it is useless for decisions. The violence behind the reputation sits in geography you will never visit. What you will actually face is four specific patterns, and three decisions cover them.

DECISION 1

Pick your map before you book

The gap between the South Zone and the statistics is categorical, not incremental.

- ☐ Book Tier 1: **Ipanema, Leblon, Barra da Tijuca, Botafogo, Urca.** Ipanema and Leblon recorded zero homicides in Q1 2026.
- ☐ **Copacabana is not Ipanema:** robberies up 25%, thefts up 56% year over year. Fine by day on Avenida Atlântica; skip the perpendicular side streets after dark.
- ☐ Centro after 18:00, and any favela without professional accompaniment: no.

DECISION 2

Decide transport once, not per ride

- ☐ The **GIG arrival corridor runs the Linha Vermelha through Zona Norte.** Book pre-arranged professional transport for the airport, both directions. Ride-hail is for the South Zone, not this corridor.
- ☐ After dark inside the South Zone: ride-hail (Uber, 99), door to door, never a street hail.
- ☐ Confirm the car from the lobby and walk out when it arrives.

DECISION 3

Set the pattern protocol before you fly

- ☐ **The PIX pattern** (Brazil's instant-payment rail): express-kidnap crews force transfers from the victim's own phone. Most visitors cannot hold PIX; the coercion lands on the apps you do carry. Set transfer limits and app locks before you fly; cap any PIX wallet (Wise, for example) the day you add it.
- ☐ **Beach rule:** take nothing you would mind losing. The arrastão is a crowd sweep, and it works on whatever is on your towel.
- ☐ Phone pocketed on sidewalks, earbuds for navigation. A phone is taken in Rio roughly every seven minutes.

On Vanguard movements these rules hold at professional grade, vetted drivers and route intelligence included. Rio does not require courage. It requires three decisions made early.
